Sixth Form Admissions

George Abbot School will welcome applications from internal students who have attended Year 11 of the school during the 2019/20 academic year.

George Abbot School will also accept applications for entry to the Sixth Form from external applicants. The Published Admission Number for external applicants for entry to Year 12 in September 2020 will be 15, but more places may be available subject to the take up by internal applicants. Acceptance onto a programme of subjects/courses is subject to a student having achieved the entry requirements. Students should refer to the Sixth Form Prospectus for the individual subject requirements. Individual subjects may be limited in the number of students they can accommodate.

Should applications from suitably qualified external students exceed the number of places available, the following oversubscription criteria will apply.

1. Looked After and Previously Looked After Children
2. Exceptional Circumstances
3. Other applicants on the basis of nearness to George Abbot School, measured in a straight line from the address point of the student's house, as set by Ordnance Survey, to the nearest school gate for students to use. This is calculated using the Admission and Transport Team's Geographical Information System
