If you do not have Google Chrome on your home device, it is quick and easy to install.


Search 'Chrome Download' in your Internet Search Engine of choice. Click on the below link:




Get more done with the new Google **Chrome**. A more simple, secure, and faster web browser than ever, with Google's smarts built-in. **Download** now.

You will then be taken to the Google Chrome main page, which will look like this:



Click on  and then  in the following dialogue box.

A pop-up will appear, with a number of options. Select 'Run' and Chrome will begin to install.



Google Chrome will automatically open a window once it has finished installing on your device, which you can immediately use to start browsing the




internet.

It will also create a shortcut on your desktop that looks like this:

When using Google Chrome, we also recommend using Incognito mode to access the SLE.

To do this, all you need to do is navigate to the school's Home Learning page at <http://www.kingscollegeguildford.com/home-learning> and right click on the Student Learning Environment logo and select 'Open new incognito window', as shown below.



This will bring you to the standard login page. Here you will be able to log in with the details for your child's year group, provided on the school's Home Learning page.
